Curbside Recycling Alternatives



LATEX PAINT DISPOSAL

Dried out latex paint (water-based) is an acceptable item for curbside trash. You can mix absorbent material (i.e. cat litter, sawdust, shredded newspaper) into paint and allow mixture to dry thoroughly or simply remove the lid and let the paint dry out.
