Dear Resident:

The Wastewater Advisory Committee is a committee of the Peninsula Planning Commission. The committee was created to study the feasibility of installing a centralized wastewater collection and treatment system focusing on the central area of the village, sometimes referred to as "the sidewalk area". The Committee has made two prior formal public presentations of its findings and analysis. The open house scheduled for 1:00 to 4:00pm, November 12, at the Peninsula Library is an opportunity for village residents to learn about progress on the wastewater study and to get their questions and concerns addressed on a one-on-one basis. Since this is an open house format, you can come at your convenience any time between 1:00pm and 4:00pm. Information posters and maps will be set up describing different aspects of the project and Committee members will be available to answer questions and record any concerns raised by residents.

The Committee recently completed the process of evaluating professional engineering firms, to determine if a centralized wastewater system is technically and financially feasible. This determination is referred to as a Preliminary Engineering Report and is required by the Ohio EPA. The Committee is recommending that Stantec Consulting, an engineering consulting company with offices in Cleveland, be employed by the Village of Peninsula. Stantec has experience in designing wastewater systems and assisting villages such as Peninsula access grants and loans to finance a wastewater system. It is anticipated that the contract with Stantec will be submitted for review to the Village Council on Monday, November 14th at the regular council meeting. It is also anticipated that on November 28th, Stantec will make a presentation of its planned activities and work output to the Village Council, the Planning Commission, and interested citizens. As part of its proposed contract, Stantec will conduct additional public engagement meetings to insure that residents' needs and concerns are addressed. It should be emphasized that the proposed contract with Stantec is NOT a commitment to install a wastewater system. It is a Preliminary Engineering Report to determine if a wastewater system is technically and financially feasible.
