AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Peninsula, Ohio through the Village Council has determined that the ordinances of the Municipality that are permanent and general in nature should be recodified.

WHEREAS, the Village of Peninsula, Ohio has heretofore entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane Company to prepare and publish such recodification.

WHEREAS, the recodification of such ordinance together with the new matters to be adopted, amended, and repealed are before the Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

Section 1. That the ordinances of the Village of Peninsula, Ohio of a general and permanent nature, as revised, codified, rearranged and consolidated into component codes, titles, chapters and sections are hereby approved, adopted and enacted as the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Peninsula, Ohio:

Section 2. That the Provisions of the Ordinance, including all provisions of the Codified Ordinances, shall be in full force and effect as provided in Section 6 of this Ordinance. All ordinances and resolutions or parts enacted prior to October 1, 2015, which are inconsistent with any provision of the Codified Ordinances, are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance, except as follows: the enactment of the of the Codified Ordinances shall not be construed to affect a right or liability accrued or incurred under any legislative provisions prior to the effective date of such enactment, or an action or proceeding for the enforcement of such right or liability. Such enactment shall not be construed to relieve any person from punishment for an act committed in violation of any such legislative provision, nor to affect an indictment or prosecution. For such purposes, any such legislative provision shall continue in full force notwithstanding its repeal for the purpose of revision and codification.

Section 3. That a specific summary of this Ordinance shall be published by the Village Fiscal Officer. The publication shall contain notice that the complete text of this Ordinance may be obtained or viewed, at the office of the Village Fiscal Officer. The Village Solicitor shall review the summary to ensure that the summary is legally accurate and sufficient.

Section 4. That each section of the Codified Ordinances without a history at the end indicates that the section contains new material is hereby enacted by this adopting ordinance.

Section 5. That through authentication and approval of this Ordinance, the Mayor and Fiscal Officer shall certify that the permanent and general ordinances of the Municipality as codified are correctly set forth and constitute the Codified Ordinances of the village of Peninsula, Ohio.

Section 6. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and related to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 7. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of the Codified Ordinances to the officials and residents of the Municipality so as to facilitate administration, daily operation and avoid legal entanglements including conflict with State Law, and shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council.
