ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2013 BUDGET FOR THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village Council has adopted the budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2013 and ending December 31, 2013, and;

WHEREAS, the Village Fiscal Officer has recommended adjustments to appropriations the approved budget; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that the adjustments to appropriations are necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and comfort of the residents of the Village;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

Section 1: Adjustment of Appropriations: The appropriations set forth in the 2013 budget are adjusted as follows::

Section 2: Severability: This Ordinance and the various parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable. Should any part, sentence, paragraph, section, or clause be declared unconstitutional, null, or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not have any effect on the validity of the remaining parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses of this Ordinance.


Section 3: Open Meeting: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: Emergency: That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and comfort; the

specific necessity is the need to ensure the immediate availability of funds to support the essential operations of the Village for 2013.

Section 5: Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect on June 10, 2013.


