AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT PRO TEM OF COUNCIL (IN PLACE OF THE MAYOR) AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BOSTON TOWNSHIP FOR THE PURCHASE OF ROAD SALT

WHEREAS, the Village has traditionally entered into a cooperative agreement with Boston Township for the purchase of road salt; and

WHEREAS, the Village has investigated its options with respect to the purchase of road salt for this winter season and has determined that purchasing salt from Boston Township is the most economical method for the Village to purchase, receive, and store the road salt needed by the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Council hereby authorizes, retroactively, the President Pro Tem of Council (in place of the Mayor) and Fiscal Officer to enter into the attached Agreement for the purchase of road salt from Boston Township. The term of the Agreement is from November 1, 2016 through October 31 of 2017, and the price for the salt is \$51.47 per ton, plus a \$3.00 per ton loading charge.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that it is necessary for the safety of those driving within and through the Village during this winter season, and therefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

AGREEMENT Road Salt

The VILLAGE in consideration for the salt purchased shall pay the TOWNSHIP the sum of Life out 47 per ton purchased. In addition the VILLAGE shall pay the TOWNSHIP the sum of Life Dollars (\$3.0) per ton loaded for labor and associated costs.

The TOWNSHIP shall invoice the VILLAGE monthly for all salt purchased and related costs. The VILLAGE shall immediately reimburse the TOWNSHIP for invoices submitted.

It is mutually agreed that this agreement is limited to the terms of this agreement, and no extra work or materials shall be charged or requested unless agreed upon in writing by all parties.
