RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA ("VILLAGE"), THROUGH THE MAYOR, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CUYAHOGA VALLEY PRESERVATION AND SCENIC RAILWAY ASSOCIATION ("RAILWAY") AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village desires to have the Mayor enter into a one-year term agreement with the Cuyahoga Valley Preservation and Scenic Railway Association, 2325 Stine Road, Peninsula, Ohio 44264, for Village services provided to the passengers of the Railway in consideration of \$5,000.00 to the Village;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:


Section 1: Contract: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the Village of Peninsula, to enter into an agreement with the Railway in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2: Open Meeting: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: Emergency: That this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience and general welfare of the inhabitants. The Agreement gives the Village an opportunity to receive compensation for the utilization of Village services which has occurred in the past without compensation. The compensation will add to the budget of the Village. The Resolution immediately resolves this issue and promotes the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Peninsula. This Resolution has received the necessary number of votes to take effect and will be enforced from and after its passage at the earliest period allowed by law.


Section 4: Effective Date: This Resolution shall take effect on Sept. 10, 2012.


