**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO THE

SECTION 1. That the Fiscal Officer recommends and Council hereby increases the appropriations within the 2017 Annual Appropriation Resolution in the amounts indicated as follows:

SECTION 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that this action is required by state law and is necessary for the operation of the Village, and therefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 14 day of August, 2017.
