A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA, SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SUMMIT COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND SUMMIT COUNTY OVI TASK FORCE MEMBER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Peninsula, known as the contractor, shall actively participate as a member of the Summit County OVI Task Force and provide coordinated overtime alcohol-related enforcement as pre-approved by the Summit County OVI Task Force, the Village of Peninsula will participate in monthly Task Force meetings and will provide the Task Force with an update of the Village of Peninsula's overtime enforcement activity for the reporting period; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Peninsula shall participate in planning and conducting countywide and localized media events/activities, highlighting the Summit County OVI Task Force's initiatives related to the reduction of alcohol related crashes in the county; and

WHEREAS the Village of Peninsula Police Department's enforcement personnel involved in approved alcohol related overtime enforcement activity are certified in the appropriate type of training, documentation of certifications are maintained by the Village of Peninsula Police Department and made available to the Summit County Sheriff's office and/or OCJS-TS.

WHEREAS no equipment purchases shall be approved under the agreement except as pre-approved by the Summit County Sheriff's office and OCJS-TS; and

WHEREAS the Village of Peninsula provides all reports and other required documentation to be submitted to the Summit County Sheriff's office as stated within this agreement.

WHEREAS the agreement is binding as of the date of approval by Council and appropriate signature of the Village of Peninsula Chief of Police valid through September 30, 2016.

WHEREAS reimbursement will be on an actual cost basis. Costs incurred by the Village of Peninsula must be submitted with the proper documentation to the Summit County Sheriff's office.

WHEREAS the Village of Peninsula Police Department as represented by the Chief of Police will abide by the provisions included within the agreement; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, and to-wit:

Section 1 Authorization

Council hereby authorizes the Village of Peninsula Police Chief to enter into an agreement between the Summit County Sheriff's office and the Summit County OVI Task Force Member.

Section 2 Severability

This Resolution and the various parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable. Should any part, sentence, paragraph, section, or clause be declared unconstitutional, null, or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not have any effect on the validity of the remaining parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses of this Resolution.

Section 3 Open Meeting


That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 Emergency

That this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants. The extension of the Contract is necessary to ensure the citizens of the Village continue to receive waste and recyclable collection services and timely notice must be provided 180 days prior to the end of the term pursuant to the Contract terms. This Resolution has received the necessary number of votes to take effect and will be enforced from and after its passage at the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 5 Effective Date: This Resolution shall take effect on the 14 day of September 2015.
