RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Summit County Fiscal Officer filed for an extension beyond the statutory date of 1 day of Sept 2015 for the Summit County Budget Commission to provide final certification of tax levies; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Taxation, Office of the Tax Commissioner granted said request and provided the Summit County Budget Commission until November 10, 2014 to complete said work; and

WHEREAS, simultaneously, the Ohio Tax Commissioner extended the statutory deadline until November 12, 2015 for the Village of Peninsula to authorize the necessary tax levies; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Budget Commission provided the amended amounts and rates and authorized the necessary tax levy to the Village on or about 12 day of Nov 2015;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

Section 1 Adoption: That the amounts and rates as determined by the Summit County Budget Commission are hereby accepted; and the Village Council hereby authorizes the necessary tax levies and certifies said tax levies to the Summit County Fiscal Officer as provided in the attached Exhibit A.

Section 2 Severability: This Resolution and the various parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses thereof are hereby declared severable. Should any part, sentence, paragraph, section, or clause be declared unconstitutional, null, or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not have any effect on the validity of the remaining parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses of this Resolution.


Section 3 Open Meeting: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and related to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of

its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 Emergency: That this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and comfort; the specific necessity is the need to facilitate the timely, appropriate, sound, and necessary fiscal administration of the Village of Peninsula as well as to comply with statutory deadline of Section 5705.35 of the Revised Code, as extended by the Tax Commissioner; and that the Resolution received the necessary number of votes to take effect and be enforced from an after its passage as it shall be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 5 Effective Date: This Resolution shall take effect on the 13 day of Oct 2015.


