A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA (“VILLAGE”) TO AUTHORIZE THE DISPOSAL OF THE L-3 CAMERA SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council authorizes the Chief of Police to dispose of the L-3 Camera System, which is no longer being used. New equipment has been installed at the Police Department and Village Hall.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to-wit:

Section 1 The Village Council authorizes the disposal of the L-3 Camera System.

Section 2 Severability: This Resolution and the various parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable. Should any part, sentence, paragraph, section, or clause be declared unconstitutional, null, or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not have any effect on the validity of the remaining parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses of this Resolution.


Section 3 Open Meeting: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 Emergency: that this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants.

Section 5 Effective Date:






