AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO PURCHASE TASERS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM AXON ENTERPRISE, INC.

WHEREAS, the Police Department is in need of two additional TASERS; and

WHEREAS, the Village Police Chief has investigated the Village's options with respect to the acquisition of those TASERS and has determined that purchasing the TASERS from Axon Enterprise Inc. is the most cost effective and budget friendly way of purchasing the TASERS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and Fiscal Officer to purchase two TASERS from Axon Enterprise, Inc. of Scottsdale, Arizona pursuant to the \$3,879.84 quote that is attached hereto and incorporated herein. The quote requires a \$1,732.84 down payment plus a \$35 shipping and handling cost along with four subsequent \$528 annual payments. The money to purchase the TASERS shall come from the Village's Law Enforcement Trust Fund.

SECTION 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that it is necessary for the proper protection of persons and property in the Village, and therefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 10 day of October, 2017.
