AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO THE 2017 ANNUAL APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION AND/OR TRANSFERRING ITEMS ALREADY APPROPRIATED IN THAT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, as a result of certain occurrences, information, and expenditures, amendments to the year 2017 Appropriation Resolution and/or transfers of items already appropriated in the Appropriation Resolution are required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. That in order to provide for certain expenditures during the 2017 calendar year, Council hereby and herein authorizes the amendments to the Year 2017 Appropriation Resolution and transfers of items already appropriated in the Year 2017 Appropriation Resolution in the amounts and to the funds indicated as follows:

Increase: Account Number 1000-620-500, Capital Outlay, from \$90,000 to \$130,000



SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that this action is required by state law and is necessary for the operation of the Village, and therefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 13 day of November, 2017.




