**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONTINUANCE OF THE ONE MILL CEMETARY MAINTENANCE TAX FOR THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA AND BOSTON TOWNSHIP UNION CEMETARY ASSOCIATION**

WHEREAS, the Village of Peninsula and Boston Township have entered into a Union Cemetery Association to manage the public cemeteries; and

WHEREAS, the joint meeting of the Village Council and Township Board of Trustees was held on May 8, 2017 at the Peninsula Village Hall; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council and Township Board of Trustees believe that continuation of the one mill levy on taxable property for cemetery purposes is in the best interests of the Village and Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby and herein authorizes the continuation of the levy of the one mill (1.0 mill) tax upon taxable property for cemetery purposes for the tax year 2017.

SECTION 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that it is necessary for the Union Cemetery Association to continue to receive funds to operate and maintain the cemeteries, and therefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 8 day of May, 2017.
