A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MS CONSULTING INC, TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the EPA administers financial assistance for asbestos abatement and clean up.

WHEREAS, the Village of Peninsula wishes to apply for grant funds from the EPA for asbestos abatement for the Players Barn in the amount of \$200,000.00 with no village share for the Players Barn project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio

SECTION 1. That MS CONSULTING INC. is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the EPA for asbestos abatement for the Players Barn and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance at no cost to the Village.

SECTION 2. That the Council for the Village of Peninsula gives approval to the Mayor to sign the above referenced grant application for financial assistance as prepared by MS CONSULTING INC at no cost to the Village.

SECTION 3. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meeting open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village residents and shall therefore take effect and be in force from and immediately after the passage.

Section 4. Effective Date of this Resolution shall take effect on the 8 day of Dec. 2014.
