AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT SERVICES AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE, AS A METRO SWAT PARTICIPATING JURISDICTION, FOR THE CITY OF STOW TO PERFORM BOOKKEEPING, FUND RETENTION, AND PAYMENT SERVICES FOR METRO SWAT

WHEREAS, the Village is a participating jurisdiction in Metro SWAT; and

WHEREAS, Metro SWAT desires to enter into an Administrative Support Services Agreement with the City of Stow for the City to perform bookkeeping, fund retention, and payment services for Metro SWAT; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement between Metro SWAT and the City of Stow is required to be authorized by the Metro SWAT participating jurisdictions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the attached Administrative Support Services Agreement between Metro SWAT and the City of Stow as a Metro SWAT participating jurisdiction for the period from the 2018 effective date of the Agreement through December 31, 2020.


SECTION 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that it is in the best interests of the Village as a Metro SWAT participating jurisdiction that the Agreement with the City of Stow be approved, executed, and implemented as soon as possible, and therefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 8 day of January, 2018.


