AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 139.08 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA, OHIO REGARDING UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Peninsula Codified Ordinance 139.08 sets forth the policy and procedures for uniforms and equipment for Peninsula, Ohio Law Enforcement.

WHEREAS, Upon review to administer this policy certain amendments must be made to maintain the administration of this policy in a cost effective manner so that the Village of Peninsula, Ohio law enforcement can maintain fiscal accountability.

WHEREAS, These amendments to section 139.08 are attached and marked as Exhibit A. Specifically, Section (d); Section (e) and Section (f) have been added to amend this ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. That Ordinance 139.08 of the Codified Ordinance be amended to administer the monetary allowances for equipment and uniforms in a cost effective manner as set forth on the attached EXHIBIT A


Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after January 1, 2016

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and related to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 11 day of January 2016



139.08 UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT.

- (a) The Chief of Police shall designate the items of clothing and equipment which shall be required for each Officer per the police policy manual.
- (b) Only those items designated in accordance with subsection (a) hereof may be purchased with the Uniform Allowance for Police Personnel.
- (c) Uniform allowance is allocated in the first month of the beginning of the New Year and shall consist of \$550.00 for full-time officers and \$300.00 for part-time officers. \$250.00 for auxiliary officers.
- (d) Any officer who does not complete the six-month probationary period will be required to reimburse the Village for the amount of uniform allowance used.

PROPOSED CHANGES 01-11-2016 in Red

139.08 UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT.

- (a) The Chief of Police shall designate the items of clothing and equipment which shall be required for each Officer per the police policy manual.
- (b) Only those items designated in accordance with subsection (a) hereof may be purchased with the Uniform Allowance for Police Personnel.
- (c) Uniform allowance is allocated in the first month of the beginning of the New Year and shall consist of \$550.00 for full-time officers and \$300.00 for part-time officers. \$250.00 for auxiliary officers.
- (d) The Chief of Police will submit a requisition form to the fiscal officer requesting a purchase order to be issued to each officer for uniform allowance at the beginning of each year and for newly hired officers. Fiscal Officer will then issue each officer a purchase order for the designated amount to spend.
- (e) All purchases will be made with the purchase order by the officers and all bills to be forward to the fiscal officer and then approved by the Chief of Police prior to payment by the fiscal officer.
- (f) No officer will be reimbursed for any purchased unless approved by the Mayor and Chief of Police.
- (d) Any officer who does not complete the six-month probationary period will be required to reimburse the Village for the amount of uniform allowance used.
