AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH THE COMPENSATION OF THE ZONING INSPECTOR

WHEREAS, the position of Zoning Inspector is now vacant, and the duties of such position are temporarily being handled by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council want to clarify the compensation for the position of Zoning Inspector prior to filling the position on a permanent basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Zoning Inspector Compensation. If the position of Zoning Inspector is held by a person that is otherwise employed by the Village in another primary capacity, the Zoning Inspector shall be compensated for time spent on Zoning Inspector matters at the established hourly rate for their other primary Village position. If the Zoning Inspector is not employed by the Village in any other capacity, the Zoning Inspector shall be paid a salary of \$375.00 for each quarter of the year worked as Zoning Inspector.


SECTION 2. Any Ordinances that were previously adopted that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that it will permit a necessary Municipal position to be filled and will assist with the operation of a Municipal department, and therefore, this Ordinance shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 11 day of April, 2016.


