**ORDINANCE APPROVING APPOINTMENT OF ZONING INSPECTOR AND  
SETTING ZONING INSPECTOR COMPENSATION AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the position of Zoning Inspector for the Village of Peninsula is now vacant;  
and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor has nominated Rebecca Garner for the position of Zoning  
Inspector; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council has determined it is in the best interest of the Village to  
have the Zoning Inspector compensated at an hourly rate;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula,  
Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

Section 1: Approval of Appointment: Council approves the Mayor's appointment of  
Rebecca Garner as Village Zoning Inspector effective immediately.

Section 2: Zoning Inspector Compensation: Effective immediately, the position of  
Zoning Inspector shall no longer be compensated at a monthly rate. The Zoning Inspector shall  
receive \$12.00 per hour for each hour the Zoning Inspector provides services to the Village. The  
Zoning Inspector shall not work for the Village more than 24 hours in any week, including any  
services unrelated to zoning, without prior approval.

Section 3: Severability: This Ordinance and the various parts, sentences, paragraphs,  
sections, and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable. Should any part, sentence,  
paragraph, section, or clause be declared unconstitutional, null, or void by a court of competent  
jurisdiction, such declaration shall not have any effect on the validity of the remaining parts,  
sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses of this Ordinance.

Section 4: Open Meeting: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this  
Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open  
meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees  
that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all  
legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 5: Emergency: That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure  
necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and comfort; the  
specific necessity is the need to ensure the immediate enforcement of the Village's zoning  
ordinance.

Section 6: Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect on July 8, 2013.


