A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA COUNCIL (“VILLAGE”) AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BOSTON TOWNSHIP (“TOWNSHIP”) LEVYING TAX FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF CEMETERIES.

WHEREAS, the Village and the Township have entered a union for cemetery purposes; and

WHEREAS, the a joint meeting of the Village Council and the Township Board of Trustees was held on June 12, 2014, at the Peninsula Village Hall; and

WHEREAS the Village Council and the Township Board of Trustees believe continuation of the one mill levy on taxable property for cemetery purposes is in the best interest of the Village and Township;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to-wit:

Section 1 Tax

That there is hereby levied upon the taxable property in the Village and the Township for the purpose of maintenance of cemeteries for the tax year 2014, a tax of one mill (1.0 mills).

Section 2 Severability

This Resolution and the various parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable. Should any part, sentence, paragraph, section, or clause be declared unconstitutional, null, or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not have any effect on the validity of the remaining parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses of this Resolution.

Section 3 Open Meeting

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 Emergency

That this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants. The extension of the Contract is necessary to ensure the citizens of the Village continue to receive waste and recyclable collection services

and timely notice must be provided 180 days prior to the end of the term pursuant to the Contract terms. This Resolution has received the necessary number of votes to take effect and will be enforced from and after its passage at the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 5 Effective Date: This Resolution shall take effect on the 19 day of July 2014.


