**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO THE
2016 APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION AND/OR TRANSFERRING ITEMS ALREADY
APPROPRIATED IN THAT RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, as the result of certain occurrences, information, and expenditures, amendments to the year 2016 Appropriation Resolution and/or transfers of items already appropriated in the Appropriation Resolution are required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. That in order to provide for certain expenditures during the 2016 calendar year, Council hereby and herein authorizes the following amendments to the Year 2016 Appropriation Resolution and/or transfers of items already appropriated in the year 2016 Appropriation Resolution in the amounts and to the funds set forth in the attachment hereto that is incorporated herein by reference.

Line Item 1000-755-344: Tax Collection Fees increased from to \$95,000 to \$101,000.

SECTION 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 12 day of December, 2016.

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


