A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING NUMBERING ERRORS WITH ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS FROM THE JANUARY, FEBRUARY AND MARCH 2015 COUNCIL MEETINGS AND STATING FOR THE RECORD THAT THE FOLLOWING NUMBERS DO NOT HAVE CORRESPONDING LEGISLATION: ORDINANCES 1-2015, 2-2015; RESOLUTIONS 3-2015, 4-2015, 5-2015 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1. That the numbering system currently in place calls for sequential numbering that is separate for Ordinances and Resolutions.

Section 2. That the numbering for the legislation presented to Council from January through March combined both Ordinances and Resolutions in the sequential numbering, thereby creating what appears to be missing legislation.


Section 3. That the following numbers do not and will not have corresponding legislation: Ordinances 1-2015, 2-2015; Resolutions 3-2015, 4-2015 and 5-2015.

Section 4. From this time forward the numbering system will be separate and sequential for Ordinances and separate and sequential for Resolutions.

Section 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the village's residents and to allow for the continued operations of the village and shall take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.

Section 6. Effective Date this Resolution shall take effect on the 13 day of April 2015.
