**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO THE
2016 ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, as a result of certain occurrences, information, and expenditures, an amendment to the year 2016 Appropriation Ordinance is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. That the Fiscal Officer recommends and Council hereby increases the appropriations within the 2016 Annual Appropriation Ordinance in the amount indicated as follows:

100-630-500 Capital Outlay	\$10,000


SECTION 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that this action is required by state law and is necessary for the operation of the Village, and therefore, this Ordinance shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 13 day of June, 2016.


