JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA (“VILLAGE”) AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BOSTON TOWNSHIP (“TOWNSHIP”) LEVYING TAX FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF CEMETERIES

WHEREAS, the Village and the Township have entered a union for cemetery purposes; and

WHEREAS, a joint meeting of the Village Council and Township Board of Trustees was held on May 14, 2012, at Peninsula Village Hall;

WHEREAS, the Village Council and Township Board of Trustees believe continuation of a one mill levy on taxable property for cemetery purposes is in the best interest of the Township and the Village;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, and the Trustees of Boston Township, Summit County, Ohio, in joint meeting assembled, to wit:

Section 1: Tax: That there is hereby levied upon the taxable property in the Village and the Township for the purpose of maintenance of cemeteries for the tax year 2012, a tax of one mill (1.0 mills).

Section 2: Certification: That the Fiscal Officer of the Village of Peninsula is instructed to certify such rate to the Summit County Fiscal Officer for assessment and collection.

Section 3: Severability: This Joint Resolution and the various parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable. Should any part, sentence, paragraph, section, or clause be declared unconstitutional, null, or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not have any effect on the validity of the remaining parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses of this Joint Resolution.

Section 4: Open Meeting: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Village Council and the Township Board of Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Joint Resolution were adopted in an open meeting and that all deliberations that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: Effective Date: This Joint Resolution shall take effect on June 11, 2012.


