A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA (“VILLAGE”), PENINSULA, OHIO, SUMMIT COUNTY, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT (“COUNTY”) FOR PAYMENT IN LIEU OF TAXES (PILT) DISTRIBUTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this agreement is made for Tax Year 2014 by and between the County of Summit, Ohio (the “County”) and the Village of Peninsula (the “Village”); and

WHEREAS, because the CVNP lands are owned by the federal government, ordinary real estate taxes for those lands are not paid or collected, and instead, a Payment in Lieu of Taxes (“PILT”) is paid to the County for a period of time after the acquisition of each parcel of land by the federal government; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio law, the County has sole discretion on how to use and/or distribute the PILT funds it receives; and

WHEREAS, the County has decided to distribute the PILT funds for Tax Year 2014 to the communities where the CVNP lands are located, in the manner set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto, which takes into account both the amount of CVNP lands within each community and the percentage of each community’s lands that are CVNP land; and

WHEREAS, using the calculation set forth on Exhibit A, the County intends to distribute the sum of \$3,771.10 to the Village of Peninsula.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, and to-wit:

Section 1 Purpose: This resolution allows for the Village to receive \$3,771.10 as its share of PILT funds collected by the County for Tax Year 2014.

Section 2 Contract: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the Village of Peninsula to enter into an agreement with the County for Tax Year 2014 PILT distributions as in the attached agreement Exhibit A.

Section 3 Severability: This Resolution and the various parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable. Should any part, sentence, paragraph, section, or clause be declared unconstitutional, null, or


void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not have any effect on the validity of the remaining parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses of this Resolution.

Section 4 Open Meeting: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: Emergency: that this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants.


Section 6 Effective Date: This Resolution shall take effect on the 14 day of Sept 2015.


