**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA (“VILLAGE”) THROUGH THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR NATIONAL PARK SERVICE FOR SEASONAL FOOT PATROL WITHIN THE CORE BUSINESS DISTRICT OF THE VILLAGE AND *DECLARING AN EMERGENCY***

**WHEREAS**, the Village and the National Park Service continue to support their partnership; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council has agreed that the Village Police Department provide additional police officer(s) for foot patrol within the Core Business District during high visitation times to protect visitors, resources, merchants, residents, and others; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the Village to enter into an agreement with the National Park Service for the one- time payment/reimbursement of services provided on the dates provided within the agreement (Exhibit A);

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to-wit:

Section 1 Contract: The Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the Village, to enter into an agreement, Exhibit A with the National Park Service, 2016 fiscal year retroactive from October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016).

Section 2 Severability: This Resolution and the various parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable. Should any part, sentence, paragraph, section, or clause be declared unconstitutional, null, or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not have any effect on the validity of the remaining parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses of this Resolution.

Section 3 Open Meeting: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the


public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 Emergency:

That this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and comfort; the specific necessity is the need to ensure immediate ongoing fiscal administration of the Village and provide for the essential operations of the Village.

Section 5 Effective Date: This Resolution shall take effect on the 12 day of October 2015.


