AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A LETTER AGREEMENT WITH THE CUYAHOGA VALLEY NATIONAL PARK FOR SEASONAL POLICE FOOT PATROL SERVICES IN THE VILLAGE'S CORE BUSINESS DISTRICT

WHEREAS, in past years, the Village and the Cuyahoga Valley National Park (the "Park") have entered into an agreement in which the Park pays the Village Police Department to perform seasonal foot patrol services in the Village's core business district; and

WHEREAS, the Park has requested that the Village enter into an agreement for the Park's 2018 Fiscal Year, which runs from October 1, 2017--September 30, 2018, based upon the terms and procedures set forth in the attached letter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into the attached letter agreement with the Park for the performance of seasonal police foot patrols in the Village's core business district.

SECTION 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that it is necessary for the Village to receive compensation pursuant to the agreement, and therefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 10 day of October, 2017.


