RESOLUTION TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS OF FOUR ACCOUNTS OF THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA AND WITHIN THE 2015 BUDGET AND *DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.*

WHEREAS, the Village of Peninsula Fiscal Officer has adopted the budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2015, and;

WHEREAS, the Village of Peninsula Fiscal Officer has recommended increase of appropriations within the 2015 budget:

WHEREAS, The Village of Peninsula Council had determined that the increased appropriations to the account is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and comfort of the residents of the Village;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to-wit:

Section 1 Purpose.

Adjustments to accounts as stated and to be set forth in the 2015 budget.

Section 2 Authorization:

The Village of Peninsula Council hereby adopts the adjustments to the 2015 operating budget as proposed and prepared by the Village Fiscal Officer.

Section 2 Severability:

This Resolution and the various parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable. Should any part, sentence, paragraph, section, or clause be declared unconstitutional, null, or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not have any effect on the validity of the remaining parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses of this Resolution.

Section 3 Open Meeting:

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4 Emergency:




