A NONBINDING RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL EXPRESSING APPROVAL AS TO THE PURSUIT OF A FEDERAL GRANT FOR THE FURTHERANCE OF THE MILL STREET BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the duly elected Village Council of the Village of Peninsula, Ohio wishes to express, in sincerest terms, its genuine desire to see the furtherance of civic pride and the well-being of all the citizens of the Village; and,

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the aforementioned goals, Council Member Mary Booth has proposed the Mill Street Beautification Project; and,

WHEREAS, the duly elected Village Council of the Village of Peninsula, Ohio, deems it necessary and proper to express their mutual support for the Mill Street Beautification Project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DULY ELECTED COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA, OHIO, TO WIT:

Section 1: Purpose: The duly elected Council of the Village of Peninsula, Ohio hereby declares its support for the stated goals of fostering civic pride, perpetuating good will among the citizenry, and improving local properties and assets by the application of Federal grant programs and local improvement initiatives hereafter designated the Mill Street Beautification Project.



Section 3: Severability: This Resolution and the various parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable. Should any part, sentence, paragraph, section, or clause be declared unconstitutional, null, or void by a court of competent jurisdiction,

such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 5: Effective Date: This Resolution shall take effect on February 13, 2012.




