RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO INQUIRE INTO OBTAINING LOAN TO PURCHASE A PARKING PAY STATION.

WHEREAS, the Village intends to provide for metered street parking within the Village;
and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to purchase a parking meter pay station to provide for collection of fees and enforcement of metered parking; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to finance the purchase of the parking meter pay station to be repaid through revenue generated from parking fees;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

Section 1: Authorization: The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the Village of Peninsula, to solicit quotes for loans to fund the parking pay station. The Fiscal Officer is not authorized to enter into any agreement or issue any securities without further authorization from Village Council.

Section 2: Severability: This resolution and the various parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable. Should any part, sentence, paragraph, section, or clause be declared unconstitutional, null, or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not have any effect on the validity of the remaining parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses of this Resolution.

Section 3: Open Meeting: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
