**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT PRO TEM OF COUNCIL AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BOSTON TOWNSHIP FOR THE PURCHASE OF ROAD SALT**

WHEREAS, the Village has traditionally entered into a cooperative agreement with Boston Township for the purchase of road salt; and

WHEREAS, the Village has investigated its options with respect to the purchase of road salt for this winter season and has determined that purchasing salt from Boston Township is the most economical method for the Village to purchase, receive, and store the road salt needed by the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby authorizes the President Pro Tem of Council (in place of the Mayor due to the fact that the Mayor is employed by Boston Township) and Fiscal Officer to enter into the attached Agreement for the purchase of road salt from Boston Township. The term of this Agreement is from November 1, 2017 through October 31 of 2018, and the price for the salt is \$48.47 per ton, plus a \$3.00 per ton loading charge.

SECTION 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that it is necessary for the safety of those driving within and through the Village during this winter season, and therefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 10 day of October, 2017.




