AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO RENEW THE VILLAGE'S EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE AGREEMENT WITH NFP CORPORATE SERVICES THROUGH THE SUMMIT COUNTY HEALTH CONNECTION FOR THE 2018 CALENDAR YEAR

WHEREAS, the Village's employee health insurance coverage agreement expires on December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, for the past several years, the Village has obtained its employee health insurance at reduced rates through the Summit County Health Connection; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Health Connection and Village have received an extremely favorable renewal rate quote for 2018; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with NFP Corporate Services and the County of Summit for employee health insurance for the 2018 calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into the attached 2018 Renewal Agreement for employee medical insurance for the 2018 calendar year with NFP Corporate Services and the County of Summit based upon the attached rates and terms.



All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that it is necessary for the protection and retention of the Village's full-time employees, and therefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 12 day of November, 2017.




