AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH REPUBLIC SERVICES OF OHIO HAULING, LLC FOR THE COLLECTION OF RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE AND RECYCLING FOR 2018-2020

WHEREAS, the Village's residential garbage and recycling collection contract with Republic Services expires on December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Village advertised for bids for a proposed new contract pursuant to law; and

WHEREAS, the bids were opened publicly on October 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Council has reviewed the bids that were received and the qualifications of the bidders and has decided that the bid of Republic Services of Ohio Hauling, LLC is the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement substantially similar to the attached three year contract with Republic Services of Ohio Hauling, LLC for the provision of residential garbage and recycling collection services to Village residents at the per home per month costs set forth in the attached contract (\$15.95 for 2018, \$16.59 for 2019, and \$17.25 for 2020 and senior discount prices of \$14.10 for 2018, \$14.66 for 2019, and \$15.25 for 2020), pursuant to the specifications contained in the bid package, the bid of Republic Services, and the specifications contained in the contract.


SECTION 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that it is necessary for the collection and disposal of residential garbage and recycling in the Village, and therefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 13 day of November, 2017.


