**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION REAPPOINTING BRADRIC T. BRYAN OF  
GOODWIN & BRYAN, LLP AS THE VILLAGE'S SOLICITOR AND PROSECUTOR  
FOR A TERM COMMENCING ON APRIL 1, 2017 AND ENDING ON MARCH 31, 2018**

WHEREAS, Section 733.48 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the Village Council may provide legal counsel for the Village; and

WHEREAS, Bradric T. Bryan was appointed as the Village's Solicitor and Prosecutor on March 21, 2016 for a one year term commencing on April 1, 2016 and ending on March 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to reappoint Bradric T. Bryan of Goodwin & Bryan, LLP as the Village's Solicitor and Prosecutor for another one year term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby and herein reappoints Bradric T. Bryan of Goodwin & Bryan, LLP as the Village's Solicitor and Prosecutor for a subsequent one year term commencing on April 1, 2017 and ending on March 31, 2018 based upon the terms of the Contract that is attached hereto and incorporated by reference. The Mayor is hereby and herein directed to execute the attached Legal Services Contract on behalf of the Village.

SECTION 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 13 day of February, 2017.







**LEGAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR VILLAGE SOLICITOR AND PROSECUTOR**

This Agreement is entered into this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2017, by and between the Village of Peninsula, Ohio ("Village"), an Ohio municipal corporation, and Bradric T. Bryan of Goodwin & Bryan, LLP, 22050 Mastick Road, Fairview Park, Ohio 44126, an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Ohio.

WHEREAS, Section 733.48 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the Village Council may provide legal counsel for the Village; and

WHEREAS, Bradric T. Bryan is an attorney and partner with the law firm of Goodwin & Bryan, LLP who was appointed as the Village's Solicitor and Prosecutor on March 21, 2016 for a one year term commencing on April 1, 2016 and ending on March 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, by way of Village Resolution 02-2017, the Village Council reappointed Bradric T. Bryan of Goodwin & Bryan, LLP as the Village's Solicitor and Prosecutor for a new one year term, effective April 1, 2017.

NOW THEREFORE, the Village, through its Mayor and as Certified by its Fiscal Officer, hereby enters into the within Agreement regarding Bradric T. Bryan of Goodwin & Bryan, LLP's service as the Solicitor and Prosecutor for the Village, as follows.

1. Term. This Solicitor and Prosecutor reappointment is effective April 1, 2017 for a one year term expiring March 31, 2018.

2. Scope of Work and Compensation. Mr. Bryan and Goodwin & Bryan, LLP shall attend Regular and Special Council, Planning Commission, and BZA Meetings, and perform all necessary legal and prosecutorial work for the Village for a fixed rate monthly retainer in the amount of \$4,415 per month (a total of \$52,980 for the 12 month period). Mr. Bryan/Goodwin & Bryan, LLP shall be required to perform at least an average of 37 hours of attorney legal work per month for the Village. The monthly retainer is payable to Goodwin & Bryan, LLP no later than the last day of the month, starting April of 2017.
