**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CHAPTER 941 OF THE CODIFIED
ORDINANCES RELATING TO THE USE OF PUBLIC WAYS BY SERVICE
PROVIDERS**

WHEREAS, increasing demands are being made on the Village's streets and rights of way to accommodate facilities of telecommunications and other service providers; and

WHEREAS, it is in the Village's best interest to manage the occupancy and use of the Village's streets and rights of way by telecommunications and other service providers to the extent permitted by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby and herein enacts Chapter 941 of the Streets, Utilities, and Public Services Code as is indicated in the attachment hereto.

SECTION 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason there is a need to accommodate and manage the increasing demand for the use of public rights of way in the Village, and therefore, this Ordinance shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 10 day of October, 2017.




