AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION APPOINTING PRISCILLA ALLAMAN AS THE VILLAGE'S HEARING EXAMINER FOR THE PARKING VIOLATIONS BUREAU

WHEREAS, by way of Village Ordinance 10-2015 and as authorized by Chapter 4521 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Village established a Parking Violations Bureau; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the Parking Violations Bureau, the Village is required to appoint a Hearing Examiner who is either an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Ohio or someone that was formerly employed as a law enforcement officer; and

WHEREAS, Priscilla Allaman is a retired law enforcement officer who is qualified and desires to be appointed as the Hearing Examiner for the Parking Violations Bureau, and the Mayor and Council wish to appoint Ms. Allaman as the Hearing Examiner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby and herein appoints Priscilla Allaman as the Village's Parking Violations Bureau Hearing Examiner, effective immediately. Ms. Allaman has volunteered to perform this position without pay.

SECTION 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.






