AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION TO MAKE TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE FOR THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1, 2018 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2018

WHEREAS, the Village is required by law to make temporary appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures for the period from January 1, 2018 through March 31, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. That in order to provide funds for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village for the period from January 1, 2018 through March 31, 2018, the following appropriations are hereby made, by fund, that are set forth in the attachment hereto that is incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw his warrants for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers thereof, or a resolution shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance; provided further, that the appropriations or contingencies can only be expended upon approval of Council for items or expenses constituting a legal obligation against the Village and for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations.

SECTION 3. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that this action is required by state law and in order to expend funds and is necessary for the operation of the Village, and therefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 15 day of December, 2017.

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


