AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PENINSULA FOUNDATION'S EFFORTS TO OBTAIN FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF OHIO CAPITAL APPROPRIATIONS BILL FOR FISCAL YEARS 2019 AND 2020 TO IMPROVE THE ADA ACCESSIBILITY OF THE G.A.R. HALL

WHEREAS, the Peninsula Foundation is a non-profit organization that was formed in 1997 by the late Robert L. Hunker to preserve the heritage, character, and vitality of the Village of Peninsula and Cuyahoga Valley; engage in historic preservation; and promote arts and educational programming in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Peninsula Foundation owns and maintains over 20 historic properties in the Village, including the Grand Army of the Republic Hall; and

WHEREAS, the G.A.R. Hall was built in 1851 and used as a one-room schoolhouse until 1888 when the building was remodeled into a meeting place for Civil War veterans; and

WHEREAS, today, the G.A.R. Hall serves Peninsula residents and visitors as a museum, community gathering space, and performance hall for the nationally acclaimed Voices in the Valley music series.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby and herein enthusiastically supports the Peninsula Foundation's request for funds from the State of Ohio Capital Appropriations Bill for Fiscal Years 2019 and 2020 to improve the accessibility of the G.A.R. Hall in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.



This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that the Village desires to provide the Peninsula Foundation with this expression of support as promptly as possible, and therefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect upon its passage.


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SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 15 day of December, 2017.


