AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO DISPOSE OF THE VILLAGE'S 2004 FORD F550 AND 2005 FORD F250 TRUCKS BY AUCTION

WHEREAS, the Village Service Department's 2004 Ford F550 and 2005 Ford F250 trucks are no longer needed for Village purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to dispose of the vehicles by auction; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code, if the estimated value of the unneeded property is one thousand dollars or more, the sale must be authorized by legislation adopted by Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby and herein authorizes the sale of the Village Service Department's 2004 Ford F550 and 2005 Ford F250 trucks that are no longer needed for Village purposes by auction to the highest and best bidder after advertisement of the auction is made pursuant to law.

SECTION 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that this action is required by state law and the Village desires to sell the vehicles as soon as possible, and therefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect upon its passage.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 12 day of February, 2018.


