A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR, FISCAL OFFICER, AND THEIR RESPECTIVE ASSISTANTS TO SUSPEND ALL ACTIONS REGARDING THE SEWER FEES SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 931 OF THE VILLAGE'S CODIFIED ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, in December of 2017, Council enacted Chapter 931 of the Codified Ordinances, which imposed a monthly sewer fee on property owners in the Village's Wastewater Service District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby directs the Mayor, Fiscal Officer, and their respective assistants to suspend all actions regarding the sewer fee set forth in Chapter 931 of the Codified Ordinances, including, billing, collecting, processing, imposing late fees, placing unpaid charges on the tax duplicate, and requiring unpaid fees to be escrowed in connection with the sale of properties. The within suspension of actions regarding Chapter 931 shall not prohibit the processing and payment of refunds as specified in Section 2 of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. Council hereby directs the Fiscal Officer to issue a refund of Chapter 931 sewer fees paid by property owners to those property owners who request refunds from the Village. Such refunds shall be issued within thirty days of the date the refund request was received by the Village.

SECTION 3. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force as of the earliest date permitted by law.




