**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA SUPPORTING
THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CUYAHOGA RIVER WATER TRAIL AS A
DESIGNATED WATER TRAIL BY THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL
RESOURCES**

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga River Water Trail Partners have proposed the establishment of the Cuyahoga River Water Trail as a means to encourage educational, historical, cultural, recreational, and eco-friendly activities on the Cuyahoga River.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. That the Village of Peninsula declares its support for the establishment of the Cuyahoga River Water Trail as a means to encourage educational, historical, cultural, recreational, and eco-friendly activities on the Cuyahoga River.


SECTION 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Peninsula for the reason that the Cuyahoga River Water Trail Partners has requested this legislation prior to December of 2018 so that it can be included with its application, and therefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect on its passage.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 19 day of December, 2018.


