A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO RENEW THE VILLAGE'S USER AGREEMENT FOR THE SUMMIT COUNTY-AKRON REGIONAL RADIO SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the County of Summit and City of Akron own and operate a consolidated County-wide regional radio system that provides a vehicle for public safety radio communications and the coordination and interoperability of communications for public safety departments, service departments, and schools in the County; and

WHEREAS, the Village is presently a party to a User Agreement with the County of Summit and City of Akron that permits the Village to use the Summit County-Akron Regional Radio System and governs the use of that system; and

WHEREAS, the present Agreement expires on April 30, 2019, and the Regional Radio System has requested that all renewal agreements with participating jurisdictions be authorized, executed, and returned prior to February 15, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the attached Summit County-Akron Regional Radio System User Agreement for the period from May 1, 2019 through April 30, 2024. The Village's fee in connection with the Agreement is \$20 per month per radio.

SECTION 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period permitted by law.


