**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2019 FORD F-550 TRUCK FROM LEBANON FORD, INC. FOR THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT, ALONG WITH CERTAIN NECESSARY EQUIPMENT TO UP FIT THE TRUCK FOR SERVICE DEPARTMENT USE**

WHEREAS, due to the recent Service Department building fire and loss of Service Department vehicles, the Village is in need of a replacement truck for the Service Department; and

WHEREAS, advertising and bidding are not required if the purchase is made pursuant to the State's Cooperative Purchasing Program as managed by the Ohio Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined the purchase of a new 2019 Ford F-550 truck from Lebanon Ford, Inc. best balances the Village's fiscal responsibilities and the immediate needs of the Service Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby authorizes the purchase of a 2019 Ford F-550 truck from Lebanon Ford, Inc. for the price set forth in the quote that is attached hereto, which includes certain necessary equipment to up fit the truck for Service Department use.

SECTION 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force as of the earliest date permitted by law.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the 2 day of MAY, 2019.
