**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA TO PARTICIPATE  
IN THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act (Am. Sub. H.B. 100) was signed into law on December 4, 1985; and

WHEREAS, effective March 6, 1986, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act began providing the opportunity for counties, townships, municipal corporations, regional transit authorities, regional airport authorities, port authorities, school districts, conservancy districts, park districts, and other authorities to participate in contracts distributed by the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing, for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment, and certain materials.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. The Council of the Village of Peninsula hereby authorizes the Mayor and Fiscal Officer to execute all documents necessary for the Village to participate in Ohio Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, contracts distributed by the Department's Office of Cooperative Purchasing for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment, and materials pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04.

SECTION 2. The Village agrees to be bound by all contract terms and conditions as the Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing, prescribes. Such terms and conditions may include a reasonable annual membership fee to cover the administrative costs that the Department of Administrative Services incurs as a result of the Village's participation in the contract. Further, the Village and its officials and employees hereby agree to be bound by all such terms and conditions and not cause or assist in any way the misuse of such contracts or make contract disclosures to non-members of the Coop for the purpose of avoiding the requirements established by Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04.

SECTION 3. The Village agrees to directly pay the vendor under each State contract in which it participates for items it receives pursuant to the State contract.

SECTION 4. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


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SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force as of the earliest date permitted by law.


