A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO ESTABLISH A VILLAGE COUNTY CORONAVIRUS RELIEF GRANT FUND IN ORDER TO RECEIVE AND ACCOUNT FOR FEDERAL CARES ACT FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136 (the "CARES Act") was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, in House Bill 481 of the 133rd General Assembly ("H.B. 481"), the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing a portion of the funds provided to the State of Ohio by the CARES Act to Ohio counties and local subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the Village is eligible to receive certain CARES Act funds through the County of Summit; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit is requiring subdivisions receiving money from the County to establish a local Coronavirus relief fund that is separate and distinct from the local fund previously set up by the subdivisions to account for other sources of CARES Act funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council authorizes and directs the Village Fiscal Officer to create a special revenue fund within the accounts of the Village of Peninsula and name such fund the Summit County COVID-19 PSGP Fund, which will be numbered as Fund #2152.

SECTION 2. Council affirms that all funds deposited in the Village Summit County COVID-19 PSGP Fund shall be expended only to cover Village costs that were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020 and ends on December 30, 2020 that are consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), any regulations applicable thereto, and any guidance established by the U.S. Treasury Department and Auditor of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. The Village affirms it understands that this fund shall be subject to audit by the Auditor of the State of Ohio during its next regular audit under Section 117.01 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all

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deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force as of the earliest date permitted by law.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on the _____ day of _____, 2020.
