**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 139.10(g) OF THE VILLAGE'S ADMINISTRATIVE CODE RELATING TO AUXILIARY POLICE OFFICERS**

WHEREAS, on November 9, 2020, Section 147.03 of the Village Administrative Code was amended to provide that all full-time, part-time, and auxiliary police officers that work on any of the Village Holidays set forth in subsection (a) of Section 147.03 shall be paid time and one-half for the hours worked on that Holiday; and

WHEREAS, Section 139.10 of the Administrative Code, pertaining to the Auxiliary Police Unit, contains language that contradicts the amended language in Section 147.03; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to amend Section 139.10(g) to remove the language contained therein that is contrary to the intent of the amendment to Section 147.03 that was adopted by Council on November 9, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby amends Section 139.10(g) of the Village Administrative Code as set forth in the attachment hereto that is incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.022 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period permitted by law.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 8 day of March, 2021.




