A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH PAYBYPHONE TECHNOLOGIES, INC. TO PROVIDE A PAID PARKING SYSTEM TO THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the Village Planning Commission has studied different paid parking systems that could be utilized by the Village and has determined that the system provided by PayByPhone Technologies, Inc. best suits the Village's circumstances and needs; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with PayByPhone Technologies, Inc. to provide the Village with a paid parking system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Peninsula, Summit County, Ohio, to wit:

SECTION 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a Cooperation and Service Agreement with PayByPhone Technologies, Inc. based upon the terms and conditions set forth in the attached agreement or an agreement substantially similar thereto.


