As a THANK YOU to Summit County communities, the Akron Zoo is hosting *Summit County Community Appreciation Days*. The zoo would like to extend a special invitation to your community to visit the zoo. As part of our *Summit County Community Appreciation Days* program, we are offering residents of your community free admission for the entire month of September.

During *Community Appreciation Days* at the Akron Zoo, residents will enjoy free admission to the zoo for the entire month of September. Tickets are good for one free visit to the zoo and must be reserved online and in advance. Tickets will be available online at [https://www.akronzoo.org/community\\_days](https://www.akronzoo.org/community_days) and are date specific. Tickets will be limited to four tickets per household. Reserved tickets will be emailed and will only be valid for the date they have selected and cannot be exchanged. The program will be capped to 1,000 community day tickets per date to ensure a comfortable visit is enjoyed by everyone. Discounts will be applied by the constituent's address. Discounts will be applied automatically but will require the constituent to create an account, just like last year.

Enclosed are twenty tickets to distribute to those residents who do not have access to a computer. These tickets must be redeemed at the ticket counter on the day of their visit. Residents who contact the Akron Zoo for *Community Appreciation Day* tickets and cannot reserve online, will be directed to your municipality's main offices.
