



Holiday Celebrations in Peninsula

Come and celebrate the Holiday season in the Historic Village of Peninsula. Events include:

Thursday, November 30th: Candlelight Walk & Tree Lighting

- ◆ The tree, from Heritage Farms, will be lit on the Bronson Green at 6:00pm. Music will be provided by the Woodridge High School Rhapsody Singers and a Brass Ensemble. They will then move into the Bronson church for a program of Christmas and holiday music. Afterward, they will also be caroling throughout the village.
- ◆ Explore the streets, illuminated by luminaries, as you visit the various shops which will be open from 5:00-8:00pm and decorated for the holidays. Look for decorated porches as you walk the Village which will be judged at the end of the evening.
- ◆ Roasted chestnuts will be offered next to River Light Gallery.
- ◆ The Peninsula Art Academy will offer cider and cookies, art demos and activities, and live holiday music.
- ◆ See the 18th annual Mini Tree Display and purchase raffle tickets (\$3 each or 5 for \$10) for the tree of your choice. 1960's Boomer Christmas with Bill Brauning from 6:30-7:30 will feature the nostalgia of holiday songs and TV shows we remember as kids.

Saturday, December 2nd: Community Christmas Bazaar

- ◆ A wonderful opportunity to see the Historic Boston Township Hall when they host the Community Christmas Bazaar which will run from 10:00am-3:00pm. An excellent bazaar to pick up gift items which include handmade, repurposed and vintage items along with baked goods and warm beverages.

Sunday, December 10th: Reindeer Day

- ◆ Live reindeer will be behind the Bronson Church from 12:00-3:00pm with Rudolph antlers being sold for \$5.
- ◆ Festivities at the church will feature Santa and Mrs. Claus, Rudolf and The Grinch from 12:00-3:00pm.
- ◆ Elf Hunt from noon-4:00pm. Kids can hunt for hidden vintage elves throughout the village and receive a prize when completed. Maps can be picked up at the Bronson church when visiting Santa and Mrs. Claus.
